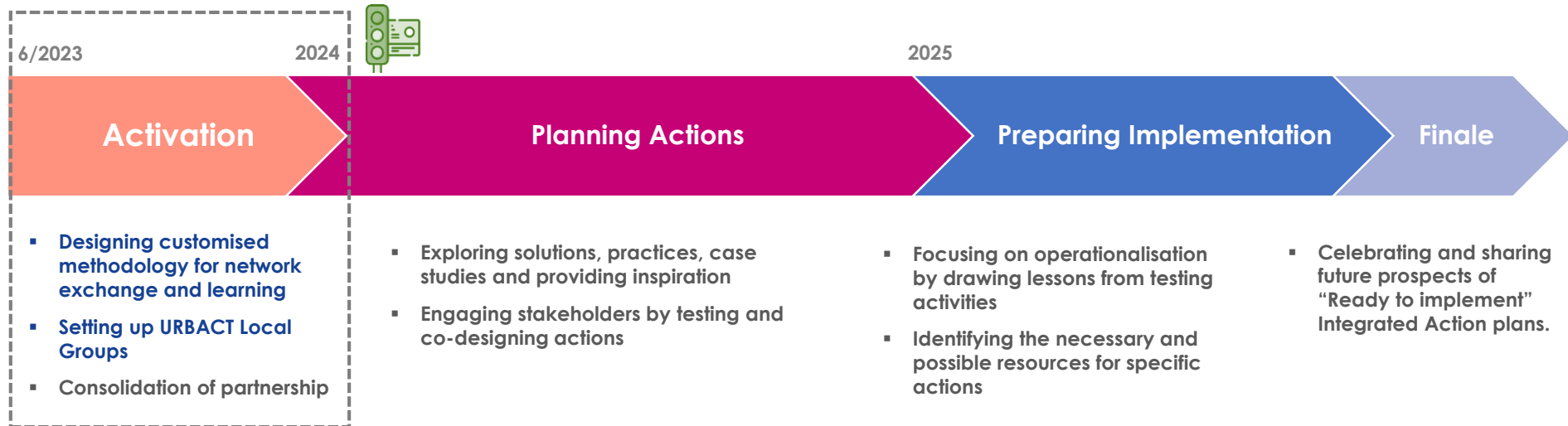
Integrated Action Plan (IAP)

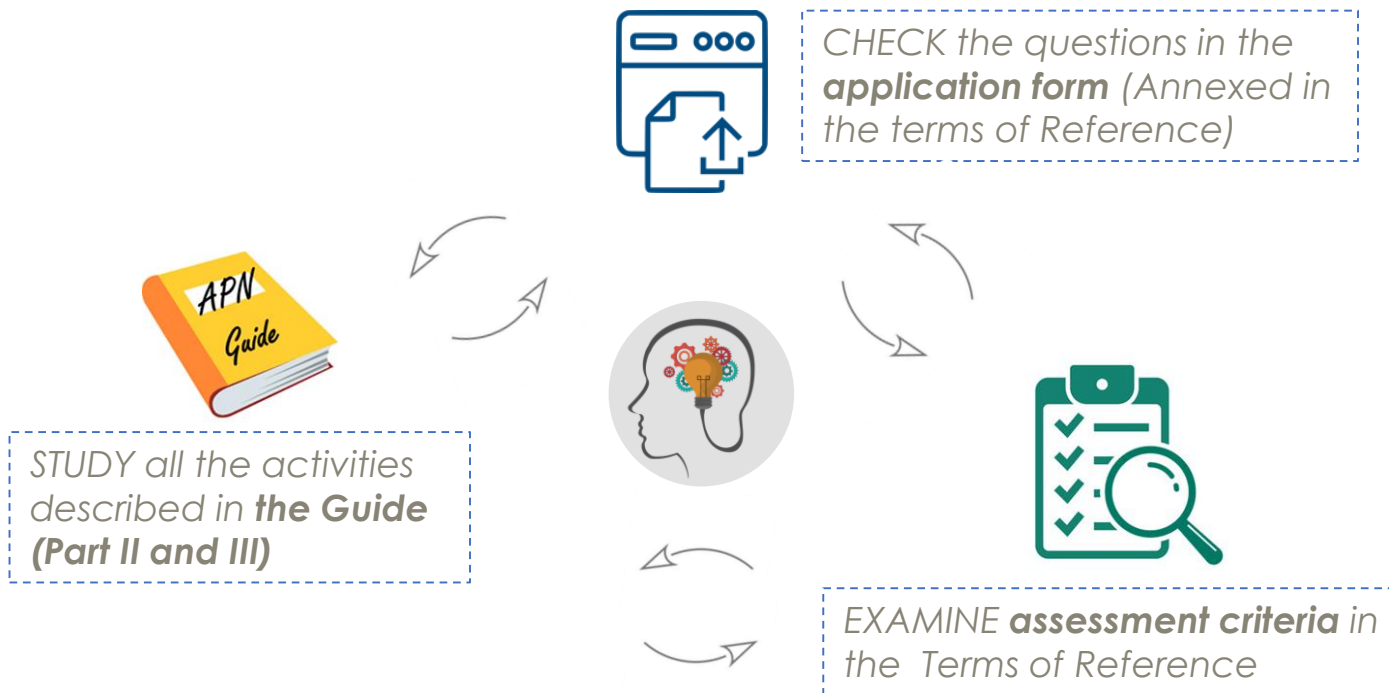

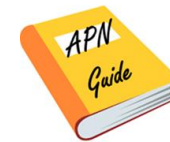

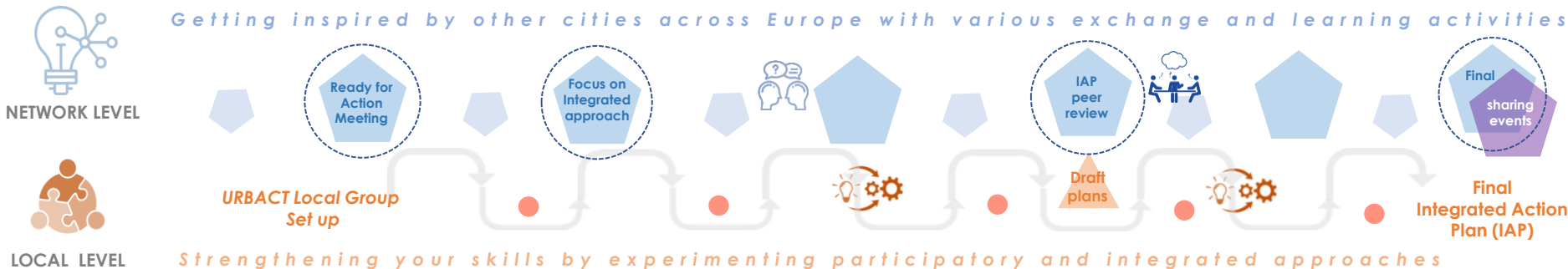


Designing your tailor-made exchange and learning journey

- Propose any additional (customised) network level activities

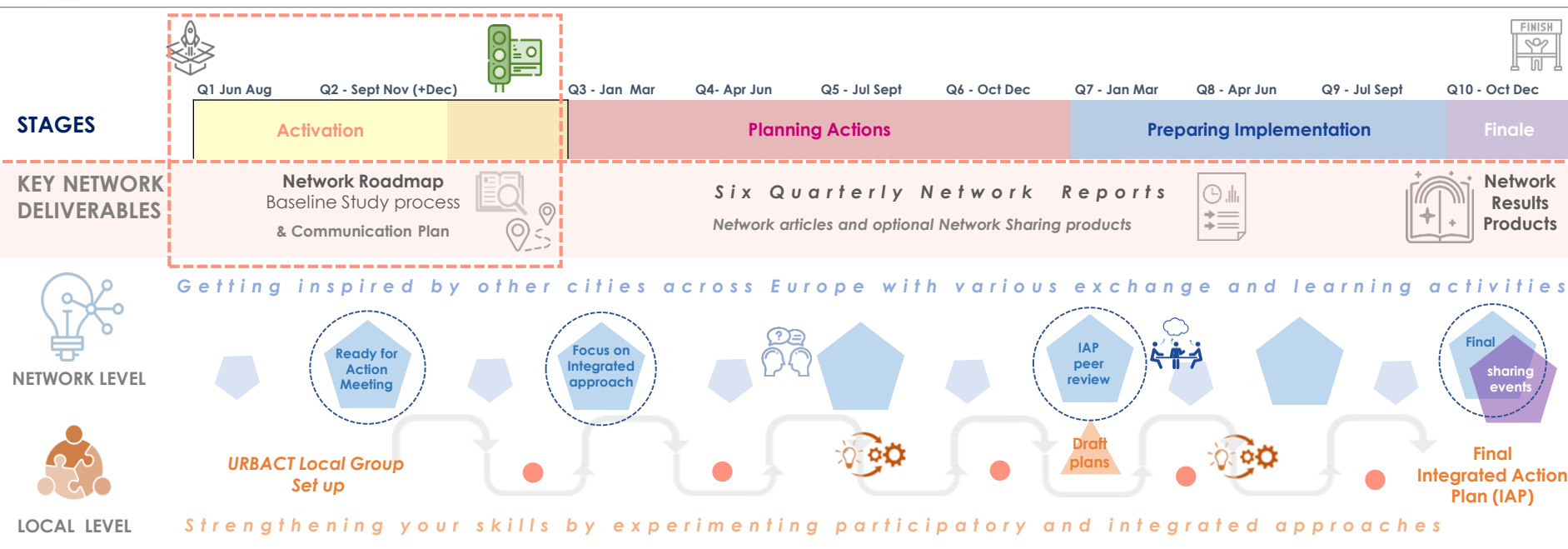
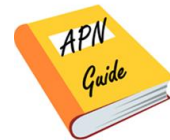
Getting inspired by other cities across Europe with various exchange and learning activities

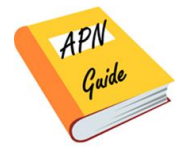
Standard and customised activities & outputs

The activities in URBACT networks are always structured around 3 Work Packages (WPs):

- WP1 — Network Management
- WP2 — Network Level (Transnational) Activities
- WP3 — Local Level Activities

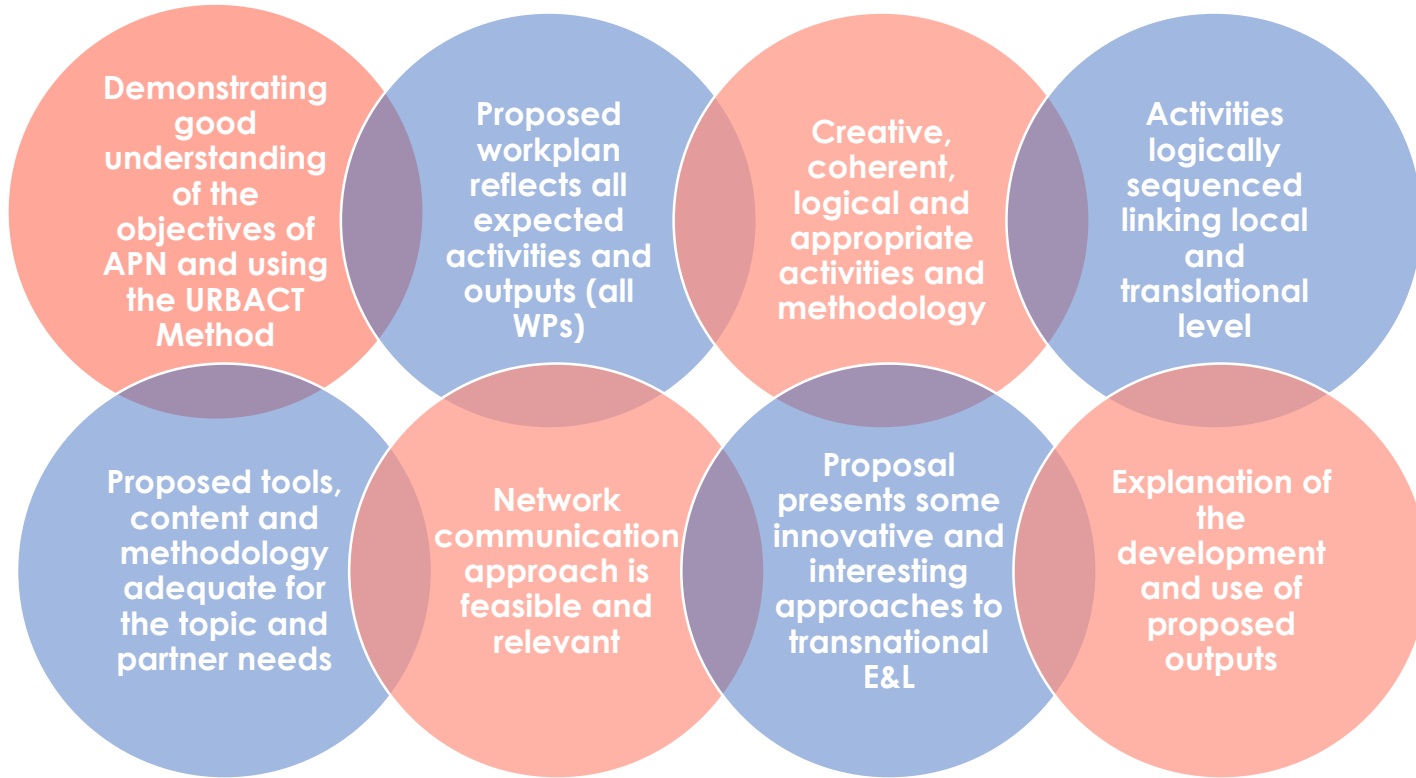

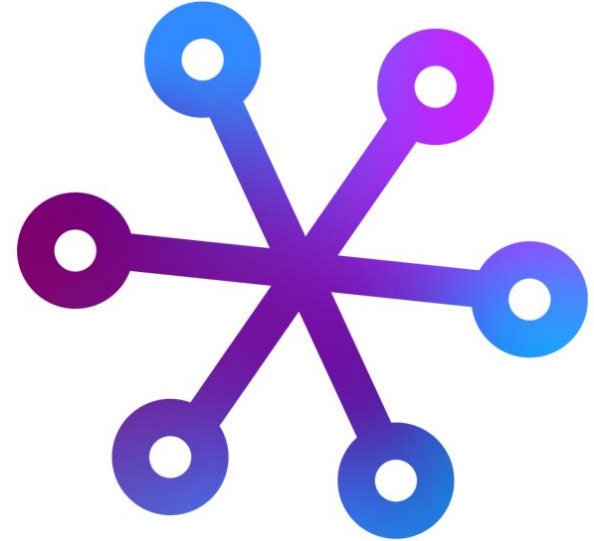
